Health Officer Qualifications:

- At least 21 years of age.
- A mature and growing Christian.
- Mental, emotional, and spiritual stability.
- Have a minimum of a certification as a wilderness first responder or has met the requirements equivalent, or any of the following: licenses physician, physician's assistant, nurse practitioner, registered nurse, practical nurse, emergency medical technician, or medical first responder.

Health Officer Requirements:

(Health Officer requirements include all the above statements under "All CLBC Staff Will Be")

- Want campers to know Christ and grow in that relationship.
- Are willing to share their faith with campers.
- Have a servant like attitude working with campers and other staff.
- Want to have tons of fun working, living, investing in staff and campers.
- Hold to the statement that "Camp is for kids".
- On time to staff meetings, assigned areas, and activities.

Responsibilities:

- Care for physical, emotional, social, and spiritual needs of campers in your cabin.
- Enforce all camp safety rules and other regulations.
- Work cooperatively with the Summer Leadership Team and other counselors and staff in larger group activities.
- Complete required paperwork at end of week.
- Perform other functions at camp as assigned.
