To be part of the SMT program students must go through an application, interview and hiring process. Center Lake views the SMT program as a vital role in the running of the Summer programming. We look for quality students who are willing to work hard, be responsible, have a servant attitude and have fun! Our application and interview process are put in place to help ensure that our SMT program and the students who make up the program continue to be a vital role in the Summer programming at Center Lake.

### Different areas of the SMT program

- **Support Staff**
  - Are students who have completed their freshman year of High School who are assigned to work areas (housekeeping, kitchen, maintenance) each week.
- **Counselor in Training**
  - Are upper classman in high school (Juniors/Seniors) who are assigned to a cabin each week. They assist the lead counselor in the cabin as a counselor in training.
- **Junior Wrangler**
  - Are students who have completed their freshman year of High School who work along the Center Lake Ranch Staff. They assist in cleaning, maintaining, and running ranch areas including the petting farm and barn.
